Lee is a retired executive of Hewlett Packard, where he worked for more than 31 years in a number of positions in the US and Asia. His last position at the company was Corporate Vice President and Managing Director of Geographic Operations, responsible for the company's operations in more than 120 countries.

During the 1988 to 1991 period, Lee served as the Senior Vice President of H&Q Asia Pacific where he led the formation of venture capital funds and management companies targeted at Thailand, South East Asia and the Philippines.

Since 2001, Lee has been a Managing Partner at WR Hambrecht Ventures Group where he led the formation of two venture funds focused on investments in early stage technology and bioscience companies in the US and China.

Lee currently serves on the boards of several public companies. He is an independent board member of Lenovo Group, the number two global PC and mobile internet company, a board member of Microelectronics Technology Inc., a leading global microwave and wireless network technology company based in Taiwan, and Neophotonics Inc, a leader in PIC photonics serving the global optical communications market based in San Jose. He also serves on a number of private company boards including CrownBio, YeePay, NeuroSky, Universe Media Holdings, Autekbio, and Genyous Biomed. In the non-profit area, Lee serves on the boards of Mills Peninsula Health Services and 1990 Institute.
